



PIERCING THE VEILS OF IDENTITY CLASSES
 (from hand-eye co-ordination to corporate wealth)

A veil is both opaque and transparent, honestly declaring (to those with good vision) the power to enforce boundary between two acknowledged territories. Veils are invisible to those of poor sight.

The personal mastery of veils is a declaration of independence and power and sometimes seen as a challenge.

The piercing a veil is an attempt to remove ambiguity powerfully imposed.

Identity classes are clearly separated areas of personal status.

This flow chart illustrates three distinct identity classes: human being, natural person and artificial person and shows the veils between them.

These veils are used by the powerful to confuse and dominate by claiming them either open or closed at their advantage.

Both state and corporate power rely on veils to pacify the public.

Natural Person (NP):
 A traditional bundle of rights and duties that can be inherited by one's heirs and family.
 A human being can be in possession one or more natural persons.
 A natural person can be created by one human being, or by two or more natural persons, or one or more artificial persons.
 Natural persons and human beings are commonly mistaken for each other.
 A natural person can be destroyed by a human being under all circumstances.
 Natural persons can be in many places at once and can only live by natural means.
 Natural persons can own, use and control.
 Natural persons can own, use and control.

Artificial Person (AP):
 A traditional bundle of rights and duties that can be inherited only by more natural persons or one or more artificial persons or by a corporation.
 An artificial person can possess one or more artificial persons.
 An artificial person can be created by two human beings, or by one or more natural persons, or one or more artificial persons, or a corporation.
 An artificial person can be destroyed by natural persons and artificial persons.
 Artificial persons can be in many places at once and can live by natural means.
 Artificial persons are connected with property and power.
 Artificial persons can own, use and control.

Human Being (HB):
 A human being is a free and rational being.
 A human being can be created by two human beings, or by one or more natural persons, or one or more artificial persons, or a corporation.
 A human being can be destroyed by natural persons and artificial persons.
 Human beings are connected with property and power.
 Human beings can own, use and control.

Significant Data:
 A human being is able to provide a secret question.

Data Influence:
 A human being is able to provide a secret question.

Inter-class Influence:
 A human being is able to provide a secret question.
